## TUESDAYS

### 10 A.M. ON THE TRAIL OF NATURE

#### Guided hike in Tulfes

The Glungezerbahn cable car takes us up to the Halsmarter middle station. From there, we trudge on snowshoes through the snow-covered winter forest to our destination, the Tulfein Alm pasture. The view of the Karwendel mountains and the Inn valley is fantastic from here! Make a rest and taste some Tyrolean dishes at Tulfein Alm before we go back to take the cable car down. On Yeti's tracks!

**Duration:** approx. 3.5 hours (walking time: 2 hours)

**Meeting point:** Glungezerbahn base station, Tulfes

**Attention:** Outside the operating hours of the Glungezerbahn, an alternative hike is offered.

### 2 P.M. THE INN AND THE RIVER TRANSPORT

#### Guided themed town tour in Hall in Tyrol

Salt, silver and shipping were once the three pillars of the burgeoning medieval town of Hall. On an extended walk from St. John Nepomuk's Church in the former salt works district to the legendary Lend Chapel St. John Nepomuk, the bridge saint, is accompanying us. Let's go to the former head station of the Tyrolean navigation. Ship ahoy!

**Duration:** approx. 1.5 hours

**Meeting point:** Hall Tourist Office, Unterer Stadtplatz 19

**TIP:** On Tuesdays and Thursdays, the Glungezerbahn (Section I) is in operation

until 10 p.m. for ski tourists and snowshoe-hikers (last descent at 10.15 p.m.). Refreshments are available at the Tulfein Alm as well as at the Halsmarter (both near the cable-car stations).

### 10 A.M. MONEY RULES THE WORLD

#### Guided museum tour in Hall - Mint Museum

Let's start in the district of the former salt works of Hall in Tyrol and experience the history of coinage, hear about the first Thaler of the world, see how money was made throughout the centuries in the museum's permanent exhibition and finally climb up the Tower of the Mint, Hall's landmark. An unforgettable view of the Karwendel mountains and the old town rounds off this themed tour! You can also stamp your own coin at the end of the tour.

## FRIDAYS

### 10 A.M. HIKING AS IN EARLY DAYS

#### Guided hike in Absam

With the eagles' eyes and binoculars in search of tracks, we get to know Austria's largest nature park from a different angle. In doing so, we will not only look forward, but also back to a time when humans and animals were closely connected to nature and exposed to numerous dangers: seven hundred years of mining in the near Halltal valley, the beginnings of alpinism, hunting and forestry shaping the landscape until today. Guided tours are held in German and English on a regular basis. Tours in French or Italian are available on request at the latest the day before. Guided tours take place from one person. Guided hikes and active hours take place from two persons and need to be booked the day before until 5 p.m. at the Hall tourist board.
