Mint Museum | Hall in Tyrol

Hall is the birthplace of the world's first taler. This exciting tour takes you to the Mint Tower and the Hall Mint Museum.

→ 5 PM OF WILD HEADS, FROGS AND A QUEEN

Themed tour | Hall in Tyrol

As early as 1411, Hall was the first town in Tyrol to have a water pipe from the Halltal valley. Stories about Hall's fountains are at the centre of the tour alongside the general history of the town.
