Hall Mint Museum

This varied tour takes you up to Hall's landmark Mint Tower and into the permanent exhibition of the museum in Hasegg Castle. It tells of Hall's history as a provincial mint and birthplace of the World's First Thaler. An unforgettable view of Karwendel and the largest old town in Tyrol round off this themed tour.

Over the centuries, numerous fountains in public spaces were designed by renowned artists, which we still encounter in the townscape today. The general history of Hall is not neglected either. A journey of discovery of a different kind!

The view over the Inn Valley and the various 3000 metre peaks on the opposite side of the valley is magnificent and guarantees a real panoramic view!

FRIDAYS

9 AM VIA THE PINE PATH TO THE LIZUMER HÜTTE

Guided hike Wattenberg

On forest paths and tracks along the ancient Swiss stone pine path Zirbenweg with beautiful views over peaks and torrents we reach the hut Lizumer Hütte. Our hiking guide tells us a lot of interesting facts about the Swiss stone pine, the so-called Queen of the Alps. At a well-deserved stop, we enjoy Tyrolean dishes and have a good time! Let's go!

4 PM THE INN AND RIVER SHIPPING

Themed tour Hall

Salt, silver and shipping were once the three pillars of the up-and-coming medieval town of Hall. An entertaining walk takes you from the former salt works district to the Untere Lend, the former head port of the Tyrolean river shipping industry, where for centuries canteens, zills and flatboats docked to tow important goods into the town.

9 AM TO THE FLOWER PARADISE OF ISSANGER

Guided hike Absam

A shuttle service (see below) takes us from the Halltal car park to St. Magdale-

na pasture. On a wild and romantic path along the Halltal torrent we hike in Austria's largest nature park, the so-called Karwendel, and enjoy the breathtaking alpine scenery. The hike leads to the Issboden, which is known for its plant diversity. Equipped with Swarovski binoculars and a bit of luck you can also observe chamois, ibex and eagles!

Attention: Mountain boots, weatherproof clothing and provisions (drinks) are absolutely necessary! As long as there is no shuttle service (October), an alternative hike will be organized.

Please note: From 20 May to 1 October 2023, a shuttle taxi runs every hour from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturdays and also Sundays (except in bad weather) from the Halltal car park to St. Magdalena car park and also back every hour.
