

# Information on MICE and COVID-19 measures

Status 02. June 2020, subjects to change



## Event size

- Until 30.06.2020: max. 100 persons
- 01.07. - 31.07.2020: max. 250 persons (indoor) or max. 500 persons (outdoor)
- From 01.08.2020: max. 500 persons (indoor) or max. 750 persons (outdoor)
- The number of persons refers exclusively to the audience, technical and organisational staff is not included here.



## Seating recommendation

We recommend that you guarantee sufficient space (at least 1 metre) between the participants in the seating arrangements for the respective seminars and that you only occupy every second chair and in a checkerboard pattern. If the minimum distance of 1 meter is not reached due to these regulations, the participants must wear a mouth-nose protection.

## Safe hospitality



### 5 rules that should ALWAYS be observed:

1. Keep at least one-meter distance from strangers
2. Do not shake hands
3. Wear a mouth and nose protection
4. Wash your hands several times a day
5. Sneeze or cough into the crook of your arm or tissue



## Mouth-Nose-Protection

In all public indoor areas all persons need to wear a mouth nose protection mask. This applies to both staff and participants. In the outdoor areas it is not necessary to wear a mask, as long as the other hygiene measures are observed (distance, hand hygiene etc.)
